Guidelines for the use of Recycling Carts

The City of Piqua Sanitation Department will begin providing curb-side recycling service **May 1, 2015**.

Recycling Carts will be provided to each customer free of charge to use for recyclable materials only.

Cart distribution will begin in April. Carts will be delivered to each refuse and recycling customer.

Do not use the new Piqua recycling cart until May 1, 2015. Rumpke will continue to pick up red bins for recycling until this time. Rumpke will take the red bins on their last collection day.

What goes in the cart?

- **Plastic:** all types of bottles
- **Glass:** bottles, jars
- **Paper:** newspaper, junk mail, cardboard, cartons
- **Cans:** aluminum and metal beverage cans, steel or tin food cans

- Recycling Carts will remain the property of the City of Piqua.
- Do NOT write on the cart or deface them in anyway.
- Recycling Carts have a unique ID number so you can identify which cart is yours.
- Recycling Carts should be left at the house or apartment if you move.
- If a cart is lost or stolen, report it to the Sanitation Department or Utility Billing Office immediately.
- Do NOT place trash or yard waste in the recycling cart.
- Place recycling carts out on your regular trash collection day.




Collection Routes are being consolidated to provide more efficient collection of all types of solid waste. See the map on the back for routes that become effective on **May 1, 2015**.
