

ODOT District 7 Current Construction

For the week of July 13th - 19th

Sidney (Monday, July 13, 2015) – The following closures are currently in effect for the week of July 13th – 19th:

Auglaize County

- **SR 197 between Moulton Ft. Amanda Road and Conant Road**, 24 HOUR ROAD CLOSURE July 13th – 17th. *The official detour is: SR 66 to SR 117 to SR 198*
- **SR 219 between Santa Fe - New Knoxville Road and Hardin Pike Road**, 24 HOUR ROAD CLOSURE July 15th – 25th. *The official detour is: SR 29 to SR 274 to I-75*
- **SR 219 between East Shelby Road and SR 29**, 24 HOUR ROAD CLOSURE July 6th through September 30th. *The official detour is: SR 29 to SR 274 to SR 66*

Champaign County

- **Champaign- SR 296 between SR 29 and Black Road in Urbana**, 24 HOUR lane closures July 13th through September 30th. One lane will remain open for travel in each direction through the use of temporary traffic signals.

Clark County

- **I-70 east and west between SR 4 and US 68**, Nightly lane closures July 8th – 31st between the hours of 6 pm and 6 am. These will become double lane closures between the hours of 7 pm and 6 am. One lane will remain open in each direction.
- **I-70 between Enon Road and US 68**, Lane addition project. Two lanes are open in each direction. In some areas, three lanes are open in each direction. **The amount of available lanes could change depending on work being done on the project.*

Darke County

- **SR 503 between SR 722 and Darke-Preble County Line Road**, 24 HOUR ROAD CLOSURE July 6th – 31st. *The official detour is: SR 722 to US 127 to US 40*

Logan County

- **SR 366 between SR 368 and County Road 38**, 24 HOUR ROAD CLOSURE July 6th – 10th. *The official detour will be: SR 708 to SR 33 to SR 274 to SR 117.*

Mercer County

- **SR 197 between US 127 and Celina-Mendon Road**, Daily lane closures June 10th through July 31st between the hours of 7 am and 5 pm. One lane will remain available in each direction through the use of flaggers.
- **US 33 between Stose Road and Celina-Mendon Road**, 24 HOUR lane width restrictions June 1st through July 15th. Lane widths will be reduced to 11'. Two lanes will remain open in each direction.

Miami County

- **Eldean Road between CR 25A(Troy) and Lytle Road**, 24 HOUR ROAD CLOSURE June 8th through November 2nd. *The official detour will be posted.*

- **I-75 north and south between Fair Road and US 36**, Nightly lane closures June 15th through July 24th between the hours of 7 pm and 7 am. One lane will remain open in each direction at all times.
- **SR 41 between SR 201 and Hufford Road**, 24 HOUR ROAD CLOSURE June 8th through September 5th. *The official detour is: Westbound- SR 201 to SR 55 to SR 202 to SR 41. Eastbound- SR 202 to SR 55 to SR 201 to SR 41*
- **CR 25A(Piqua) between Looney Road and Indian Ridge Drive**, 24 HOUR ROAD CLOSURE June 8th through October 15th. *The official detour is: Looney Road to US 36 to Troy/Sidney Road to CR 25A*
- **CR 33(Eldean) between CR 25A(Troy) and Piqua Troy Road**, 24 HOUR ROAD CLOSURE June 8th through November 4th. *The official detour is: CR 25A to West Peterson Road to Piqua Troy Road*
- **I-75 south Ramp to CR 25A near Troy**, 24 HOUR RAMP CLOSURE May 6th through September 4th. *The official detour is: I-75 south to SR 41 to I-75 north to CR 25A.*
- **Miami Shelby Road between Miami River Road and River Road**, 24 HOUR BRIDGE CLOSURE April 6th through July 31st. *The official detour is: Miami River Road to Lockington Road to River Road*

Montgomery County

- **I-70 east and west between Taywood Road and Airport Access Road**, Overnight lane closure July 14th at 8 pm through July 15th at 6 am. One lane will remain open in each direction.
- **Wilmington Pike between East Whipp Drive and Cloy Road**, 24 Hour lane closures July 7th through October 15th. One lane will remain open in each direction at all times. Two lanes will remain open in each direction during peak traffic hours.
- **SR 741 between Alex Bell Road and Orchard Run**, Overnight lane closure July 14th at 8 pm to July 15th at 6 am. One lane will remain open in each direction.
- **I-75 north between Edwin C. Moses Boulevard and Main Street**, Nightly lane closures July 13th - 15th between the hours of 11 pm and 5 am. One northbound lane will remain open at all times.
- **I-70 east and west at Dog Leg Road**, ROLLING ROAD BLOCK July 19th between the hours of 7 am - 8 am. This closure will be brief in nature, lasting approximately 15 minutes.
- **US 35 westbound ramp to I-75 southbound**, INTERMITTENT NIGHTLY RAMP CLOSURES July 2nd – August 1st between the hours of 10 pm and 5 am. *The official detour is: I-75 north to Main Street to I-75 south*
- **US 35 east and west at I-75**, Various nightly lane closures July 2nd – August 1st between the hours of 8 pm and 6 am. One lane will remain open in each direction at all times.
- **I-75 north and south between Main Street and Edwin C. Moses Boulevard**, Various nightly lane closures July 2nd – August 1st between the hours of 8 pm and 6 am. One lane will remain open in each direction at all times.
- **I-75 northbound ramp to US 35 eastbound**, INTERMITTENT NIGHTLY RAMP CLOSURES July 2nd – August 1st between the hours of 10 pm and 5 am. *The official detour is: I-75 north to US 35 west to James H. McGee Boulevard to US 35 east*

- **Hemple Road between Diamond Mill Road and Dayton Farmersville Road, 24 HOUR ROAD CLOSURE** June 22nd through August 6th. *The official detour is: Diamond Mill Road to Dayton Farmersville Road*
- **Red Cross Lane between First Street and Gibbs Lane, 24 HOUR ROAD CLOSURE** June 3, 2015 through September 1, 2016. *The official detour is: First Street to Perry Street to Second Street to Red Cross Lane*
- **SR 48 Ramp to I-70 westbound, 24 HOUR RAMP CLOSURE** June 5th through November 5th. *The official detour is: US 40 to SR 49 to Brookville Salem Road to I-70 west.*
- **I-70 between Airport Access Road and SR 48, Lane addition project.** Two lanes are open in each direction. Motorists will encounter barrels and construction in this area.
- **SR 48 between Wampler Avenue and Westbrook Road, Daily lane closures** April 20th through September 30th between the hours of 9 am and 3 pm. One lane will remain open in each direction at all times.
- **I-75 Southbound Ramp to US 35 Eastbound, 24 HOUR RAMP CLOSURE** April 13th through October 31st. *The official detour is: I-75 south to the U-turn lane at the Edwin C. Moses Blvd. exit to I-75 north to US 35 east.*
- **Meeker Road at I-70, 24 HOUR ROAD CLOSURE** February 9th through September 30th. *The official detour is: Little York Road to Frederick Pike to Meeker Road. *Aullwood Drive will be closed to through traffic from US 40 at Meeker Road. Meeker Road will be closed to through traffic between Frederick Pike and I-70 and between Little York Road and I-70.*
- **Dixie Drive north and south between US 40 and Cresthill Avenue, 24 hour lane closures** November 24th through August 2015. One lane will remain open in each direction at all times.
- **Second Street between Edwin C. Moses Boulevard and Red Cross Lane, 24 HOUR ROAD CLOSURE** May 19th through September of 2017. *Detour will be posted.*
- **Salem Avenue between Edwin C. Moses Boulevard and Robert Drive, 24 HOUR ROAD CLOSURE** May 19th through September of 2017. *Detour will be posted*
- **Robert Drive between Monument Avenue and Third Street, 24 HOUR ROAD CLOSURE** May 19th through September of 2017. *Detour will be posted*
- **Vista View Drive between Second Street and Third Street, 24 HOUR ROAD CLOSURE** May 19th through September of 2017. *Detour will be posted*
- **The ramp from US 35 eastbound to I-75 northbound, 24 HOUR RAMP CLOSURE** through September 2017. *During this time, motorists will be able to utilize the specially designed U-turn lane located at the Edwin C. Moses Boulevard exit.*
- **Robert Drive between Fifth Street and Third Street, 24 HOUR ROAD CLOSURE** through September of 2017. *The official detour during this closure is: Southbound- Perry Street to Fourth Street Northbound- Fifth Street to Wilkinson*
- **First Street between Robert Drive and Red Cross Lane, 24 HOUR ROAD CLOSURE** through September of 2017. *The official detour during this closure is: Salem Avenue/First Street to Robert Drive to Third Street to Wilkinson to First Street.*
- **The First Street, Second Street and Third Street ramps along I-75 northbound and southbound, PERMANENTLY CLOSED.** A newly constructed ramp is scheduled to open to motorists in the downtown area in December of 2016. *The official detour during*

these ramp closures is: I-75 North to US 35 East to Jefferson St to First and Third Streets. (motorists can also use Main Street or Edwin C. Moses Boulevard)

Shelby County

- **SR 29 between Cisco Road and Russell Road, 24 HOUR BRIDGE CLOSURE** July 7th through July 20th. *The official detour is: SR 47 to SR 66 to SR 705*
- **I-75/SR 29 Interchange, 24 HOUR RAMP CLOSURES** July 7th through July 20th. All exit and entrance ramps at the I-75/SR-29 interchange will be closed. Detours will be posted.
- **SR 65 between Botkins Road and Southland Road, 24 HOUR lane closures** May 18th through August 28th. One lane will remain open with traffic able to travel in each direction through the use of a signal.
- **I-75 north and south between CR 25A (Piqua) and CR 25A (Sidney), Nightly lane closures** May 11th through November 15th between the hours of 7 pm to 10 am (Monday-Thursday) and 7 pm to 7 am (Friday – Sunday). Two lanes will remain open in each direction at all times.

- **Clark – US 40 west at Old Mill Road, 24 HOUR ROAD CLOSURE** July 27th – August 10th. *The official detour is: SR 369 to SR 4 to US 40*
- **Montgomery -SR 48 between Dog Leg Road and I-70, 24 HOUR lane closures** July 20th – 24th. One lane will remain open in each direction.
- **Logan- SR 274 between SR 235 and County Road 54 in Russells Point, 24 HOUR ROAD CLOSURE** July 20th – 24th. *The official detour is: SR 65 to SR 720 to SR 235 to SR 274*
- **Auglaize- US 33 between Wapak Fisher Road and Brown Road, 24 HOUR ROAD CLOSURE** July 20th – 24th. *The official detour is: I-75 to SR 67 to SR 65*
- **Auglaize- US 33 between Wapak Fisher Road and Brown Road, 24 HOUR ROAD CLOSURE** July 27th – 31st. *The official detour is: I-75 to SR 67 to SR 65*
- **Shelby - I-75/SR 29 Interchange, 24 hour ramp restrictions** July 20th through September 30th. All ramps at this interchange will be restricted to 10' lanes.
- **Champaign- SR 29 between North Elm Tree Lane and North Street, 24 HOUR ROAD CLOSURE** August 17th – 21st. *The official detour is: SR 235 to SR 706 to SR 29*
- **Champaign- SR 55 between Heck Road and Dialton Road, 24 HOUR ROAD CLOSURE** August 24th – 28th. *The official detour is: SR 235 to US 36 to SR 560 to SR 55*
- **Champaign- SR 55 between SR 235 and St. Paris-New Carlisle Road, 24 HOUR ROAD CLOSURE** August 31st through September 4th. *The official detour is: SR 235 to US 36 to SR 560 to SR 55*

ODOT closures focus on Interstate, US and State routes. For information on local roads you will need to contact the county, city or township where the road is located. Arrow boards and signs will be in place prior to the work zone to alert motorists of the upcoming closure. All work is weather permitting. Safety is a top priority at ODOT. To help ensure the

safety of the construction workers as well as the traveling public, motorists should remain alert, reduce their speed and watch for stopped traffic while passing through the work zone.
