

**ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS**  
**City of Piqua Sidewalk ADA Compliance Program**

Electronic bids will be received for the City of Piqua Sidewalk ADA Compliance Program until 10:00 a.m. on Tuesday, February 5, 2019, at which time they will be publicly opened.

In general, the Work consists of the replacement of catch basins and the installation of concrete curbing, sidewalk, and truncated dome pavers at radii and other miscellaneous locations along the streets to be resurfaced.

The electronic bids can only be submitted through Bid Express. Plans are only available through Bid Express using the Bid Express Website & Software at: [www.bidexpress.com](http://www.bidexpress.com); Phone: 1-888-352-2439. Free registration with Bid Express will allow a BIDDER to review and print all project plans. A digital ID along with a per bid fee or monthly subscription will be required for the BIDDER to submit an electronic bid.

Each proposal must contain the full name of the party or parties submitting the proposal and all persons interested therein. Proposals shall be submitted on the forms furnished by the City through Bid Express and must be electronically endorsed by the BIDDER. The low BIDDER must be prepared to provide evidence of their experience on projects of similar size and complexity upon request by the City of Piqua. The City intends and requires that this project be completed no later than June 3, 2019.

All contractors and subcontractors involved with the project will, to the extent practicable, use Ohio products, materials, services, and labor in the implementation of their project. Additionally, contractor compliance with the Equal Employment Opportunity requirements of Ohio Administrative Code Chapter 123, the Governor's Executive Order of 1972, and Governor's Executive Order 84-9 shall be required.

BIDDER must comply with the prevailing wage rates on Public Improvements in Miami County and the City of Piqua, Ohio as determined by the Ohio Bureau of Employment Services, Wage and Hour Division, (614) 644-2239.

No BIDDER shall withdraw his Bid after the actual opening thereof.

The Owner reserves the right to reject any or all Bids, waive irregularities in any Bid, and to accept any Bid which is deemed by Owner to be most favorable to the Owner.
