SPEED LIMIT REDUCTION ACTION PLAN

PARK – BROADWAY - ASH

OVERVIEW

Background:

Piqua City Commission adoption of Ordinance 7-12 requires the reduction of the speed limit posting on portions of Park, Broadway, and Ash streets. This action was taken in response to the rerouting of SR 185. The resulting speed limit change necessitates the removal and or replacement of highway signage and implementation of the new speed limit. This document outlines the process for implementing the necessary changes.

Planned Improvements:

1. Remove 35MPH speed limit sign and replace with 25MPH speed limit sign located at or near:
 - 1363 Park Avenue
 - 514 Park Avenue
2. Remove 35MPH speed limit sign and temporarily replace with 25MPH speed limit sign and flags at or near:
 - 1229 Park Avenue
 - 1279 Park Avenue
 - 415 Ash Street
3. Remove 35MPH speed limit sign and sign support located at or near:
 - 1101 Park Avenue
 - 722 Broadway
 - 324 Broadway
 - 320 Ash Street
4. Remove 25MPH advisory speed limit sign and sign support located at or near:
 - 1261 Park Avenue
