

RECYCLE in Piqua

Every month, Piqua residents recycle more than 200,000 pounds of material! Rumpke Recycling encourages all residents to join this effort in conserving natural resources and landfill space. Curbside recycling service is included in the monthly fee for City of Piqua refuse customers.

Please fill your recycling bin with the acceptable items listed below and place at the curb each week on your regular trash collection day. A larger cart is available for \$2.50 per month. Please call (800) 223-3960 if you need a bin or a cart.

Your recyclables are processed by Rumpke Recycling in Dayton. To learn more about his process, visit www.rumpkecleanandgreen.com.

Acceptable items include:

- Plastic bottles and jugs
- Aluminum and metal cans
- Cereal and snack boxes
- Cardboard, (flattened to 2' x 3')
- Newspaper with inserts
- Junk mail and phone books
- Empty aerosol cans (tips removed)
- Glass jars and bottles
- Magazines and catalogs
- Office and computer paper
- Cartons (juice, milk and egg substitute containers)
- Clean pizza boxes (free of food and grease)

* **You do NOT have to remove labels.**

Please do not put these in your Rumpke Recycling bin:

- Garbage
- Food or yard waste
- Plastic bags
- Syringes*
- Electronics
- Buckets
- Butter tubs
- Light bulbs
- Drinking glass
- Batteries
- Ceramics or dishes
- Pots or pans
- Foil juice pouches
- Toys or clothing



*Do not place syringes or medical waste inside of recyclables. For example, plastic containers being used to dispose of sharps should be placed with garbage only and are not recyclable. They may place employees who are sorting the material at risk of serious injury.
