

What You Need to Know...

The City of Piqua Sanitation Department will begin providing trash carts in 2019.

96-gallon Trash Carts will be provided to each customer free of charge to use for the disposal of refuse.

The carts will be blue with a black lid labeled "TRASH ONLY."

Bulk items, such as furniture, can be placed next to the cart for collection (1-3 items per week only).

Customers should continue to use the blue cart with a red lid for recyclable items.

What should I do with my old trash can?

Use it for yard waste, such as grass clippings, garden items, small sticks, etc. Mark the container as "Yard Waste" or put in paper biodegradable bags for easy piqua-up.



Find a new use for it, such as store items in the garage, store pet food, store toys or sports equipment.

Place the empty can next to your new cart for disposal.

All household trash shall be placed in the cart for collection.

Trash Carts will remain the property of the City of Piqua.

Do NOT write on the cart or deface in any way.

Trash carts have a unique ID number so you can identify which cart is yours.

Trash and Recycling Carts should be left at the house or apartment if you move.

What goes in each Cart?



All Non-Recyclable Materials
Plastic Bags
Diapers
Plastic Toys/Hangers/Pots
Garden Hoses
Window Glass/Mirrors/Dishes
Electronics
Cat Litter
Food Scraps



Plastic: All Types of Bottles
Glass: Bottles, Jars
Paper: Newspaper, Junk Mail, Cardboard, Cartons
Cans: Aluminum and Metal Beverage Cans, Steel or Tin Food Cans

Guidelines for the use of Trash Carts:

If a cart is lost or stolen, report it to the Sanitation Department or Utility Billing Office immediately.

Place Trash and Recycling Carts out on your regular collection day by 7 a.m.

Customers may request a smaller cart, either 64-gallon or 32-gallon, as supplies last. Keep in mind that all trash should fit into the container each week with the lid closed. We suggest using the 96-gallon cart for several months prior to requesting a smaller size.
