### **Miami County Public Health COVID-19 Update**

**Miami County** - Miami County Public Health is issuing an update on the COVID-19 in Miami County.

As of today, Wednesday April 1, 2020, Miami County is reporting 64 positive COVID-19 cases in Miami County. Of these cases, 34 are female and 30 male.

MCPH continues to receive questions and concerns about how to stay safe in the workplace and at home if you or others around you are sick. The Center for Disease Control and Prevention and the Ohio Department of Health, have various resources available for both individuals and employers. First and foremost, if you are sick or have any COVID-19 symptoms, please stay home and contact your health care provider. COVID-19 symptoms can include:

Fever (100.4 or higher)

Dry Cough

Tiredness
