**Miami County** - Miami County Public Health is issuing an update on the COVID-19 in Miami County.

As of today, Friday, April 3, 2020, Miami County is reporting 64 positive COVID-19 cases.

Governor DeWine has extended the Stay-At-Home order until May 1, 2020. This doesn't mean we have to be inactive. Be creative and find ways to be active while practicing social distancing. Spring is here and the weather is right for taking walk or checking out nature areas. It is important that the community stays safe & healthy. MCPH wants to remind everyone in the community to:

- Stay home, especially if you are sick
- Avoid those who are sick
- Limit trips to the store
- Practice social distancing
- Wash hands with soap & water often
- Sanitize high touch areas (door knobs, handles, remotes, cell phones)
